Chez Doris is seeking a dedicated volunteer Dermatologist to provide essential dermatology care to marginalized women at our service points in downtown Montreal. This is a unique opportunity to use your skills to support women experiencing homelessness or living in precarious conditions in accessing dermatology care.

Responsibilities

- Offer dermatology consultations on a one-time or recurring basis.
- Assess and treat common skin conditions: infections, dermatitis, eczema, scabies, body lice, abscesses, fungal infections, and more.
- Prescribe treatments when permitted or provide referrals to the appropriate resource.
- Provide prevention-focused education adapted to participants' living situations.
- Collaborate with the volunteer medical team and psychosocial staff.
- Ensure all care is delivered according to ethical and professional standards.

Qualifications

- Member in good standing with the Collège des médecins du Québec (CMQ).
- Clinical experience in adult dermatology.
- Interest in community health and work with vulnerable populations.
- Sensitivity to trauma, homelessness, mental health issues, and gender-based violence.
- Respectful, non-judgmental, and collaborative approach.
