This is a unique opportunity to use your skills to support women accessing our services in accessing preventive care and screenings in a safe and confidential setting.

Responsibilities

- Provide preventive gynecological screenings (PAP tests, STI testing, pelvic exams).
- Offer counselling on contraception, menstrual health, pregnancy options, and sexual health.
- Assess and manage common concerns such as infections, pelvic pain, irregular menstruation, and more.
- Refer participants to specialized care when needed.
- Deliver trauma-informed, respectful, and participant-centered care.

Qualifications

- Member in good standing with the Collège des Médecins du Québec (CMQ) in Obstetrics & Gynecology.
- Clinical experience in women's health.
- Interest in working with women facing homelessness, trauma, or multiple vulnerabilities.
- Empathetic, delicate, and non-judgmental approach tailored to participants lived experiences.
