

Nurse-Clinician (Volunteer)

Are you a nurse-clinician looking to make a direct impact in your community?

Chez Doris is seeking a dedicated volunteer nurse-clinician to provide essential care and support to marginalized women at our service points in downtown Montreal. This is a unique opportunity to use your skills to support women experiencing precarity and/or homelessness in accessing healthcare.

Responsibilities

- Provide compassionate and comprehensive nursing care, including health assessments, wound care, and patient education on health conditions and medications.
- Conduct initial health exams to help with the triage of participant referrals to our physician and external healthcare resources (e.g. CLSC-Connexion, SIDEPE).
- Collaborate with internal staff, the health services coordinator, and the QC public health services network to advocate for participants' healthcare needs and ensure continuity of care.

Requirements

- **Minimum of 3–4 hours (1 half-day) at a time** at the clinic.
- Minimum 1 year of experience working with marginalized populations in a healthcare or social services capacity.
- Active license to practice nursing in Quebec (OIIQ).
- Bilingual (French and English).

Assets

- Prescribing RN certificate and/or expanded nursing scope of practice.
- Familiarity with trauma-informed care principles.
- Experience working with Indigenous populations.
